




- In 2015, 26% of the world's population was **under 15 years** of age
- By 2050, there will be nearly 10 billion people of which **2.6 billion will be under 18**


- Every year, nearly **1 million children die** from injuries



- **Tens of millions** more require hospital care for non-fatal injuries. Many are left with permanent disabilities or brain damage.



In 2014, approximately **15 million** people were trained in first aid by National Red Cross and Red Crescent Societies in 116 countries around the globe by more than **180,000 active first aid trainers**



Each year more than **46 million** people are reached by National Red Cross and Red Crescent Societies with first aid and preventive health messages



76 National Red Cross and Red Crescent Societies have **First Aid courses specially designed for children**
