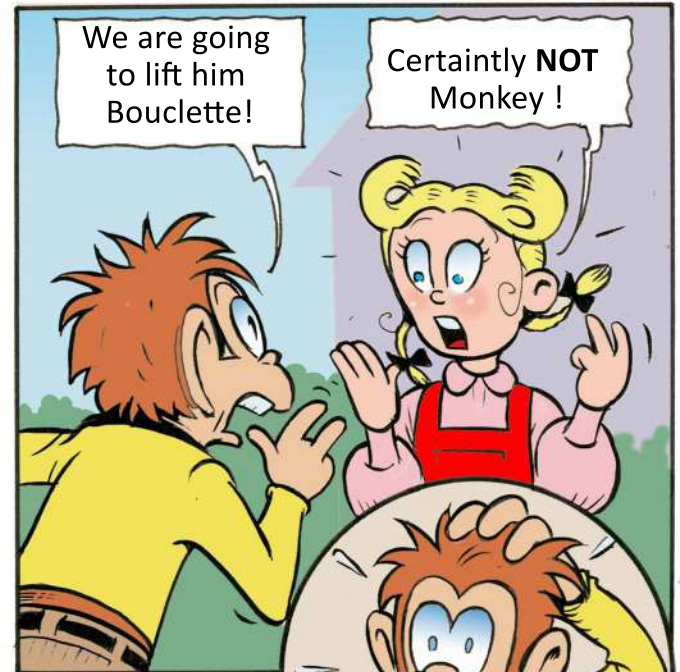


Parents Special

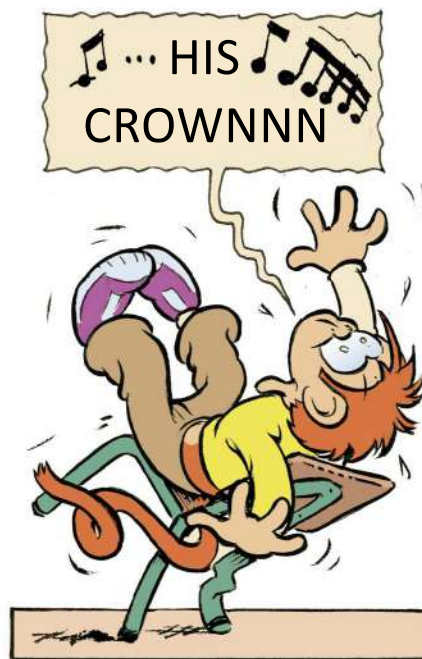
