


Learn life-saving actions for a threatening climate



Between 2000 and 2019, around **489,000 deaths** per year have been attributed to heat.



In 2023, **75.9 million** individuals were displaced within their own countries due to climate.



In 2022, approximately **3.6 billion** people resided in areas especially susceptible to the effects of global warming.

By 2023, an additional **151 million** people were affected by food insecurity, for a total of **770 million** in the world.



Climate change could cause approximately 250,000 additional deaths annually.



- Studies demonstrated in Southeast Asia that first aid training could lower mortality rates **by 30%**.
- In several West African nations, timely first aid interventions reduced preventable deaths **by 40%**.



- Early defibrillation in the first few minutes of cardiac arrest can elevate survival rates **to 80%**.
- The survival rate after out-of-hospital cardiac arrest remains below **10%** in most parts of the world.



In 2022, in Norway, 90% of students receive first aid instruction, whereas this figure drops to just 5.8% in Burkina Faso and a mere 3% in the Democratic Republic of the Congo.
